## Executive Director's Message

Green Generations is a community-based educational nonprofit serving New York City's most underserved, high-risk communities.

Our mission is to nurture and empower children with emotional-awareness and life-skills education so that they are successful in school and free to pursue their dreams in life.

At present, one in three of New York City's nearly 2 million children live in poverty, and less than 65% of children attending NYC public schools graduate high school. Of the children who graduate high school, only 1 in 3 are prepared for college or a career - [cccnewyork.org](http://cccnewyork.org).

We believe that emotional education must support academic education in order to open more doors for every child. We give children the skills to navigate life's challenges so that they do not get in the way of their successes.

2014 was an amazing year of growth for Green Generations. We continued our after-school programs for a second year at Girls Prep Charter Elementary School and P.S. 5 – The Port Morris School in the South Bronx and launched an in-school program at Northside Charter High School in Brooklyn. We also received grants from The New Yankee Stadium Community Benefits Fun and Partnerships for Parks.

To date, we empowered over 150 children and counting!

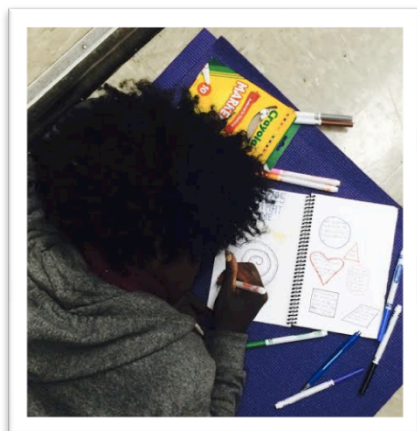
## Green Generations' Programs in Action

### GG's After-School Program

In our second year, Green Generations recruited two new groups of 24 amazing second graders, full of infinite potential, from Girls Prep Bronx Elementary Charter School and P.S. 5 – The Port Morris School in the South Bronx. The children participated in our 24-week program addressing important topics, such as: self-awareness and life-skills, nutritional empowerment, environmental stewardship, ethical and compassionate leadership, and the importance of celebration. ### GG's In-School Program



Green Generations partnered with Northside Charter High School to launch a new initiative to educate and empower over 200 ninth and tenth graders with transformative life skills that will help them become more focused, centered, and mindful.

Studies show that teens who meditate are happier, more focused, and less likely to engage in unhealthy behaviors. Green Generations designed an innovative curriculum combining yoga, meditation and visualization exercises, and journaling.

### Sustainable Saturdays

As an extension of our after-school programming, Green Generations offers children free outdoor workshops to connect with nature in St. Mary's Park, South Bronx. This year we doubled the number of children attending our program and we express gratitude to Partnerships for Parks for supporting us!

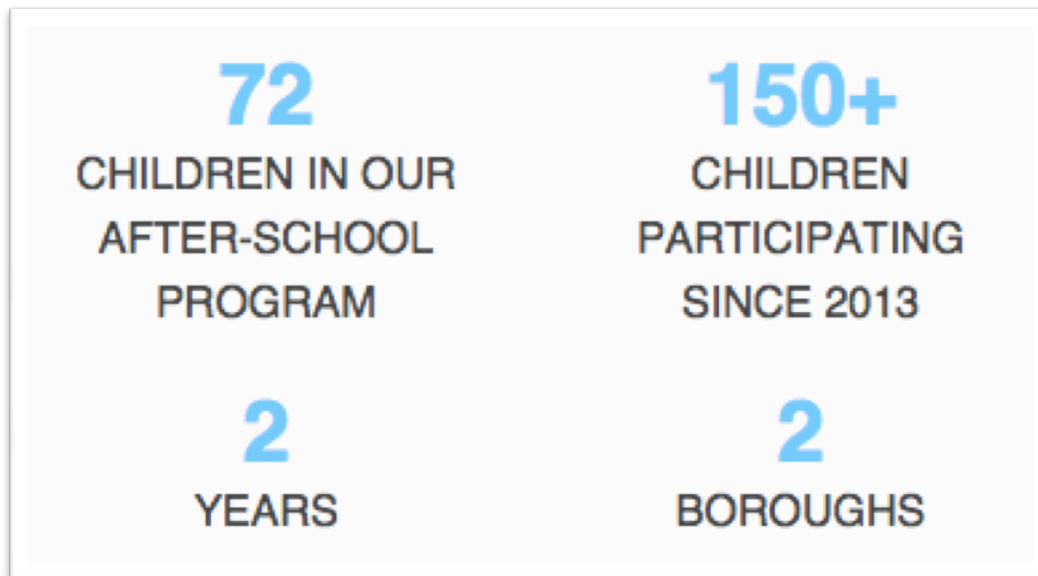

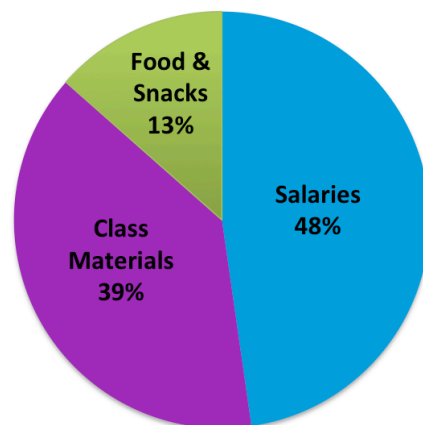

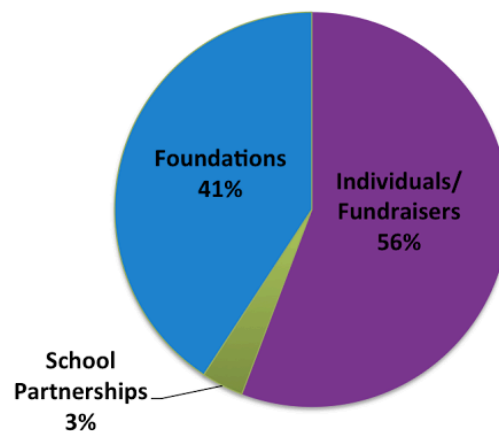
